



# NATIONAL CERTIFIED INVESTIGATOR/ INSPECTOR TRAINING SPECIALIZED PROGRAM



While the Basic Program provides a core curriculum for certification, the **Specialized Program** offers advanced certification in three individual subject areas. Each module is an eight-hour session designed to promote interaction through use of small groups, role-playing exercises and case studies. Anyone who has successfully completed the NCIT Basic training program is eligible to enroll in the Specialized program.

The Specialized Program consists of the following three units of instruction:

**Advanced Interviewing** – focusing on Cognitive Memory Retrieval as a technique to generate more accurate information from a witness and Behavioral Analysis techniques to help investigators determine the truthfulness of statements and interview subjects.

**Investigative Analysis** – consisting of Complaint Scene Analysis and Written Statement Analysis which provide methodologies and techniques for analyzing evidence in-person and in written statements.

**Investigative Report Development** – covers the integrated process of report development including developing report formats, reporting descriptive observation and activities, reporting interview information, and obtaining written statements.

## CEUs and Certification

The NCIT Specialized program concludes each module with an examination. Anyone who completes the Specialized curriculum and achieves a minimum of 70 % on the course examinations will receive CLEAR advanced certification. Continuing education units are issued through Eastern Kentucky University's Division of Special Programs.

## Hosting an NCIT Program

Sponsoring a Specialized NCIT Program is easy! CLEAR requires its sponsors to guarantee a minimum of 30 attendees from one or a combination of agencies. CLEAR staff does the rest – from arranging for meeting space to providing instructors and training materials.

## Cost:

Registration fees for the program are (US)\$400 per attendee for Members and (US)\$500 per attendee for Non-members. This includes the cost of all training materials, the examination and coffee breaks during the programs.
